D1 KUALA LUMPUR / NARITA

Assemble at the Kuala Lumpur International Airport for your flight to Narita

D2 ARRIVAL NARITA / CHITOSE / NOBORIBETSU (L/D)

Upon arrival into Narita, transfer to Haneda Airport to board a domestic flight to Chitose. Transfer to Noboribetsu for visit Samurai Village Jidaimura and Jigokudani (Hell Valley). Tonight enjoy hot spring bath in the hotel

Noboribetsu Date Jidaimura – a historical theme park highlighting city life in the Edo period. Step back in time to enjoy traditional games, activities, theaters, street performances and more

Noboribetsu Jigokudani – a spectacular, appropriately named village, which displays hot steam vents, sulfurous streams and volcanic activities

Hotel: Sekisuitei Onsen Hotel or similar Onsen Hotel

D3 NOBORIBETSU / HAKODATE (B/L/D)

After breakfast, proceed to Hakodate for city tour visiting Oshamanbe National Park, Kombu Pavillion, Goryokaku Tower and Red Bricks Warehouse. In the evening, take a Ropeway to Mt. Hakodate for a panoramic night view. Its night view is counted among the world's 3 best along with Hong Kong & Naples.

Mejikan – Red Brick Warehouses build at the end of the Meiji era now house a variety of commercial facilities and offer a lot of souvenirs

Kombu Pavilion – which the famous seaweed is shown on how it is being collected and processed through a similar iMax show.

Goryokaku – is characterized by its defenders to attack intruders from any direction in the port. A complete view of Goryokaku can be seen from the Goryokaku Tower.

Mt. Hakodate – is 334 meter high; will take only 3 minutes ride up to the brilliant mountaintop and the ropeway can accommodate 125 persons.

Hotel: Shikanoyu Onsen Hotel or similar

D4 HAKODATE / LAKE ONUMA / LAKE TOYA (B/L/D)

This morning, visit Hakodate Morning Market and Trappist Monestry. Transfer to Lake Onuma for a photo Stop. Then, proceed to **Lake Toya** and visit **Showa Shinzan Bear Ranch** and view of **Mt Showa**. Overnight at hot spring hotel.

Morning Market - is held daily from 5am (6am during winter) to noon displaying variety of fresh & dry seafood with more than 360 stalls

Trappist Monastery – was founded by French monks at the end of 19th century. The present building was constructed at the beginning of the 20th century.

Lake Onuma – is known for its picturesque, island dotted lakes and majestic dormant volcano and Mount Komagatake

Showa Shinzan Bear Ranch – Around 100 brown bears around the size of 2 meters are being bred here

Lake Toya – a volcanic calderas lake in the central part of Hokkaido

Hotel: Shikanoyu Onsen Hotel or similar

D5 LAKE TOYA / SAPPORO (B/L/D)

This morning, proceed to visit Shiraoi Ainu Village and shopping at Mitsui Outlet Park. Continue journey to Sapporo city tour, which includes: Odori Park, photo stop at Tokei-Dai (Clock Tower), local beer factory and shopping at Tanukikoji District and Susukino Ramen Valley. Today will enjoy a **Mixed Grilled Seafood with live Abalone** for lunch.

Shiraoi Ainu Village – Experience the historical and traditional Japanese lifestyle with a visit to the fully restore village. Several performances, like traditional Ainu dances, are held throughout the day.

Beer Factory – Hokkaido is the birthplace of beer in Japan. So we have chance to visit their factory and learn how the beer in process.

Tanukikoji – famous shopping street near to **Susukino area**.

Hotel: Tokyo Dome Hotel or similar

D6 SAPPORO / OTARU / SAPPORO (B/L/D)

This morning, proceed to Nijo Fresh Market and White Chocolate Factory. Then, transfer to Otaru for tour highlights: picture stop at Otaru Canal, visit Kita-Ichi **Glasswork Shop, Music Box Museum** and other souvenir shops.

Otaru – A city and port located northwest of Sapporo and also one of the Japan's leading tourist destinations.

Ishiya Chocolate Factory – famous for the Shiroi Koibito Cookies. Two thin butter cookies with white choco
