# 7D5N WORLD HERITAGE OF TOHOKU



- ☀ Akita : Lake Tazawa, Kakunodate

**DAY 1 KUALA LUMPUR / NARITA** (Meals on board)  
Assemble at Kuala Lumpur International Airport for your flight to Akita via Tokyo.

**DAY 2 AKITA / MORIOKA** (L/D)  
Upon arrival, proceed tour to :

- **Lake Tazawa** – is a crater lake situated near the center of eastern region of Akita Prefecture. It is the deepest lake in Japan, whose depth is of 423.4 meters and shape is almost perfectly circle.
- **Kakunodate** – A castletown founded by the local Lord Ashina in 1620, is a small, charming town now called “Little Kyoto of Tohoku”. The town just the right size to be explored on foot, preserves many 390-year-old samurai houses.
- **Bukeyashiki Old Town** – (literally, samurai residential avenue) has been preserved from the Edo Period (from the 18th to the early part of the 19th century), and it has been designated as a national important traditional structure preservation district.

**DAY 3 MORIOKA / SENDAI** (B/L/D)

- **Koiwai Farm** – The largest privately owned farm in Japan is also a great place for fun such as interesting exhibits cute animals and hands-on experience like wood handicrafts and milking the daily cows
- **Chusonji Tmeple** - was established in 850 as a Tendai temple. Main attraction is the Konjikido (Golden Hall), a temple hall which, like Kyoto Kinkakuji, is completely covered in gold.
- **Genbikei** – is a beautiful gorge made of cliffs 100 meters tall continuing for approximately 2 kilometers on both sides of Satetsu River, a branch of the Kitakami River

**DAY 4 SENDAI / NIIGATA** (B/L/D)

- **Matsushima** - only half an hour outside of Sendai, is famous for its bay, which is dotted by many pine clad islets and has been ranked one of Japan's three most scenic views for centuries.

- **Godaido** – is a small temple hall on an islet just next to the pier. Due to its prominent location, it has become a symbol of Matsushima. **Matsushima Fish Market**

- **Sasa Kamaboko (Fish Sausage) Factory**

**DAY 5 NIIGATA / NIKKO** (B/L/D)

- **Kitakata Ramen**
- **Aizu Wakamatsu Tsuruga Castle** – was built in 1384 and changed hands many times between the different rulers of the Aizu region.
- **Nikko** – is a town at the entrance to Nikko National Park, most famous for Toshogu Japan's most lavishly decorated shrine and the mausoleum of Tokugawa Ieyasu, the founder of the Tokugawa shogunate.

Hotel: Nikko Area Hotel or similar

**DAY 6 NIKKO / TOKYO** N (B/L/D)

- **Asakusa Kannon Temple** – Most famous and popular Buddhist temple. Built in the 7<sup>th</sup> century.
- **Nakamise Street** – more than 50 shops, which offer local specialties and tourist souvenirs.
- **Ginza** – the most prestigious and fashionable shopping & dining town in Tokyo. Shopping at Uniqlo & H&M shop
- **Mitsui Factory Outlet**

Hotel: Narita View Hotel or similar

**DAY 7 TOKYO / KUALA LUMPUR** (B/ Meals on Board)

- At Narita International Airport, after check-in and departs for KLIA. Upon arrival, safely return sweet home and the ending of the pleasant memorable trip of Honshu!
